Rules and Rewards 2017-2018 Academic Year

With 34 schools and counting, Achievement First is always looking for more talented teachers to join our Team and Family. Please read below to learn more about the rules of the referral program as well as the rewards. If you have additional questions not addressed below, please email recruitment@achievementfirst.org.

Overview

- A referral is any individual that you think would be a great addition to our network for an instructional, school-based role.
- We are currently seeking referrals for school leaders, teachers, social workers, teachers-in-residence, behavior specialists, paraprofessionals, and school culture associate roles.
- The referral program does not extend to operations positions or Network Support roles.

Referral Bonus

 As a thank you for referring your contacts, Team Recruit is excited to be able to award AF employees the following bonuses should your referral be hired.

	Referral signs an offer letter before January 1, 2018 for a 2018-19 position and is still an employee with AF on September 1, 2018.	Referral signs an offer letter on or after January 1, 2018 and is still an employee with AF on September 1, 2018 OR a referral is hired for a mid-year opening.
Principals-in-Residence and Principals	\$2,000	\$1,000
Deans, Teachers, Teachers-in-Residence, Social Workers, and Behavior Specialists/Interventionists	\$1,000	\$500
Paraprofessionals and School Culture Assistants	\$500	\$250

- For referrals hired for the 2018-19 school year, bonuses will be paid out in September 2018 should your referral still be an employee with Achievement First on September 1, 2018.
- For referrals hired for a position starting in the 2017-18 school year, bonuses will be paid out four times a year (once a quarter).
- Referral bonuses are subject to taxes and will appear in your regular paycheck.
- Please read the rules below carefully to ensure your referral submission meets all the requirements to be bonus eligible. Please note that Team Recruit will only pay out a referral bonus when the general rules below have been followed. Your referral does not qualify you for a bonus if your referral has started an application before you submit the official referral form. There will be no exceptions.

General Rules

- A referral is someone who has not applied or interviewed with Achievement First this school year (August 16, 2017 current).
- To participate in the referral bonus program, you **must submit the referral's information through the**Referral Submission Form. A link to this form can also be found on Many Minds.
- Referrals reset at the start of every school year. Only referrals submitted after August 16th, 2017 will be
 eligible for a referral bonus. Should you wish to have a previous referral reconsidered for a position in our
 schools, please resubmit their information using the official referral form.
- The referral submission <u>must</u> take place before a candidate begins an application in order to be eligible for a bonus.
- You must be the first person to refer the candidate to Team Recruit in a given school year in order to be eligible for a bonus.
 - Should two people refer the same person in the current school year, the bonus will be awarded to the first person to submit the referral form.
 - Should two people refer the same person but in different school years, the bonus will be awarded to the person that referred in the current school year.
- Referral bonuses are for referrals hired in full time instructional positions: school leaders, teachers, TIRs, social workers, behavior specialists/interventionists, paraprofessionals, and school culture assistants only.
 Referral bonuses will not be awarded for candidates hired in school-based operations positions or in Network Support roles.

Program Exceptions:

- Achievement First has agreements with various other charter networks and with Teach For America.
 Team Recruit may not be able to reach out to your referral if they work for particular schools or are a first year Teach For America corps member.
- People who have worked for AF in any capacity prior to being referred do not qualify as referrals. Should you refer a former AF staff member that is hired, you will not be eligible for the bonus.
- You cannot retroactively claim a hire. All rules must be followed above in order for you to be eligible for a referral bonus. Referrals that are emailed directly to Team Recruit are not bonus eligible.
- Principals are not eligible for bonuses for referrals that result in hires for their own school.
- Senior level network support teammates (Vice Presidents, C-level) are not eligible for referral bonuses.
- Members of Team Recruit are not eligible for referral bonuses.
