I. Call to Order (Presenters: Mayor Smiley)

Mayor Smiley called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

II. Public Comment (Presenters: Mayor Smiley)

There were no members of the public present.

III. Board Resolutions and Approvals (Presenters: Mayor Smiley)

Maryellen Butke and Mayor Smiley introduced potential board member Nicole Pollack. Ms. Butke also shared information about Janelle Clarke-Holley, who was not present, but also being considered for board membership.

IV. Executive Session: Personnel Update and Portfolio Planning (Presenters: Michael Rabin)

Mayor Smiley asked for a motion to go into executive session to discuss a personnel update and portfolio planning. Maryellen Butke motioned, JoAnn Schofield seconded. All in favor, none opposed or abstaining.

V. Our Schools Today: Building on Progress and Shaping Our Future (Presenters: Amy D'Angelo, John Sharkey, Kristin Damo, Charmayne Joseph, Dumar Paden)

Amy D'Angelo and John Sharkey led a discussion about the academic performance of their network. They noted growth in elementary reading proficiency but a decline in mock ELA State test results, highlighting the need to focus on 3rd and 4th grade reading abilities. Ms. D'Angelo discussed an increase in middle school ELA proficiency but acknowledged room for improvement. Mr. Sharkey mentioned positive signs in performance but emphasized the need for teacher development and using the right data. The team discussed implementing new curriculum and plans to focus on core instruction, with a shift towards college readiness benchmarks. However, they expressed concern over low math proficiency, attributed to the conceptual math curriculum, which they plan to address through adaptive technology. Mayor Smiley raised concerns about test preparation and summer learning loss, suggesting partnerships with other organizations and community-based resources to mitigate these issues.

VI. Finance Committee: Insights on the Financial Pulse (Presenters: Omar Mayyasi, James Wiley)

James Wiley shared that the current financial state is good. The finance team is preparing the new budget proposal by December, including teacher attainment and retention plans.

VII. AFRI Board: Partnering on Governance

Lisa Margosian shared her focus areas for the year and her expectations for the board related to engagement, attendance, and board giving. She also discussed the board's role in governance and shifting from oversight to strategic engagement.

VIII. AF 25th Anniversary and Mission Moment (Presenters: Lisa Margosian, Kevin Lohela)

Ms. Margosian shared that this year is Achievement First's 25th Anniversary and the organization's remains committed to closing the achievement gap and supporting under-resourced communities. She mentioned that there will be regional block parties and celebrations culminating with a summit at the end of the year. Then she shared a video about the 25th anniversary.

Mayor Smiley asked for a motion to adjourn. Nicole Pollack motioned, Maryellen seconded. All in favor, none opposed or abstained. The meeting adjourned at 6:57.
